Come compete in the In-Hand and Mounted Trail Obstacle classes that are part of the **Shenandoah Valley Judged Trail Ride Series**. Then enjoy a 5 mile ride on the lovely trails of Oldenacres, a wonderful estate in Goode, Va. All jumps are optional. Ride at the pace right for you & your horse. Western and gaited horses welcome!

First team out 8:30 a.m. — Last team out 11:00 p.m.

Trail classes performed prior to starting the pace course.

Four Pace Divisions: Full Cry - Hilltopper - Trail Ride - Junior

Winning time for each division is set by a member of the Bedford County Hunt. Junior teams must include one rider under the age of 18 and are measured against the Hilltopper time. A team may consist of any number of riders. Two ribbons will be awarded to the first 6 places in each division.

<u>Dress</u>: Informal with helmets required. <u>HP Entry Fee</u>: Adult - \$50 , Under 18 - \$40 Entry forms and releases are available at http://www.bedfordcountyhunt.com

<u>Trail Class Entry Fee</u>: \$10 per class or \$15 for both classes. Six ribbons awarded in each class.

Directions: GPS is not recommended. Closest address to where trailers will park is 2932 Hawkins Ridge Road, Goode, VA. **Do not turn into the driveway with the Oldenacres sign.** Follow yellow hunter pace signs to parking.

From Lynchburg: 221S past Goode post office and store. Right onto Rt. 670, Roaring Run Road (sign says Cifax). At fork, bear Left onto Rt. 637, Hawkins Ridge Rd. Continue approximately 2 miles to farm on left and follow yellow hunter pace signs to parking.

From Bedford: 221N past Otter Elementary. Cross Big Otter Bridge and turn Left onto Rt.670, Roaring Run Road (sign says Cifax). At fork, bear Left onto Rt. 637, Hawkins Ridge Rd. Continue approximately 2 miles to farm on left and follow yellow hunter pace signs to parking.

Attention large rigs: There will be someone to assist you with parking. Do not try to turn into the field with trailers before speaking with our parking director!
